- Know how to count to 30.
- Know how to name sports they like or dislike.

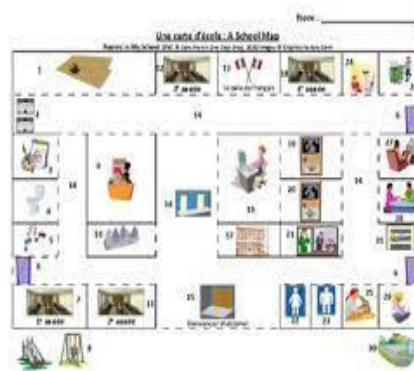
What skills will students learn? (Disciplinary Knowledge)

- Learn to label some rooms of our school.
- Practise and improve phonetical pronunciation of familiar words.
- Create lists of favourite subjects they study and translate them in French.
- Learn to express their likes and dislikes regarding certain subjects.
- Learn how to tell the time at the hour and half past in French.
- Learn how to design and play a board game.

What key knowledge will be taught? (Substantive Knowledge)

- Consolidate the phonics sounds and improve pronunciation.
- Explore different ways of working with a dictionary (English French, French English)
- Use pictures and maps to identify certain rooms.
- Form longer detailed sentences when describing themselves in French.
- Use the correct phrases when explaining their preferences or ideas.
