

What prior knowledge should students have?

- Vocabulary (Bonjour, Salut, Ca- va, asseyez vous, levez vous, écoutez, regardez)
- Know some of the days of the week, countries, methods of transport and some members of their families.
- Know how to count to 30.
- Know how to name sports they like or dislike.

What skills will students learn? (Disciplinary Knowledge)

- Learn to describe something in full sentences.
- Practise and improve phonetical pronunciation of familiar words.
- Create lists of what they see as “a lot of” using the French phrase for it.
- Learn to express correctly the masculine or feminine of a word in French.
- Learn how to label a map with countries and languages.
- Learn how to identify features of a place, such as river, flags, boats.

What key knowledge will be taught? (Substantive Knowledge)

- Consolidate the phonics sounds and improve pronunciation of words.
- Explore different ways of working with a dictionary (English French, French English).
- Use pictures and maps to identify countries, languages and other features.
- Form longer detailed sentences using the correct phrases when describing a country.
- Use the correct masculine and feminine within sentences.
