What prior knowledge should students have?

- Pupils know where to position themselves to be an effective attacker or defender.
- Pupils have begun to send the ball with a variety of passes and receive the ball while moving.
- To work as a team to close space and to retrieve the ball from the opponent.

Key Vocabulary	Definition
Pivot	To turn on one foot while keeping the other foot in contact with the ground.
Technique	A way of doing something that is effective and efficient.
Tactics	The art of devising or employing plans or stratagems to achieve a specific end.
Intercepting	The act of stopping or preventing the other team from passing the ball.
Possession	To have control of the ball.
Shoot	To throw the ball towards the goal with the intention of scoring a goal.

What skills will students learn? (Disciplinary Knowledge)

- To use the different passes in a gamer situation quickly and with accuracy.
- To understand the rules of netball and apply them to a game situation.
- To use different types of shots depending on location of the court.
- To identify space with tactical movement.

What key knowledge will be taught? (Substantive Knowledge)

- Applying knowledge and tactics to a game situation.
- To create strategies and apply them within a game to help be successful.
- Analysing and evaluating their performances to identify improvements for the future.
- To understand that you need to work collaboratively with others on the court to be successful.
