What prior knowledge should students have?

- Vocabulary (Bonjour, Au-revoir, Je m'appelle, J'aime, bonne anniversaire, J'habite à, à l'école)
- How to name some modes of transport.
- How to name members of their families.
- How to use verbs at correct tenses.

What skills will students learn? (Disciplinary Knowledge)

- Learn and practise their family members in French.
- Learn to use possessive pronouns when describing their own family.
- Learn to use masculine "mon" and feminine "ma" correctly.
- Learn and practise to recognise verbs in the past and present tense.
- Practise using the possessive adjectives, with support, to form longer, detailed sentences.
- Learn and practise using "le" and "la" for the correct words- feminine or masculine.
- Learn to describe their families using a wide range of adjectives.

What key knowledge will be taught? (Substantive Knowledge)

- Practise naming different members of their families.
- Consolidate their dialogue skills in French by asking and answering simple questions about each other's families.
- How to describe different members of their families using the correct possessive pronoun, possessive adjectives and verb tenses.
- Consolidate using the masculine and feminine of words when speaking in full sentences.
