What prior knowledge should students have?

- Managing money
- Roles in the community
- Negotiation
- Parliament and law/order
- Staying safe/emergencies
- Bullying and pressure

What skills will students learn? (Disciplinary Knowledge)

- Develop skills to make a judgement whether something is right or wrong
- Understand the reproductive system and how the body changes during puberty
- Identify what makes news 'fake'
- Recognise why rules are made and needed
- Awareness of impact of consuming on the environment

What key knowledge will be taught? (Substantive Knowledge)

- **Decision Making:** Students will learn a structured process for making choices, recognising that all decisions have consequences.
- **Puberty:** Students will gain accurate knowledge of the physical and emotional changes during puberty and learn strategies for managing these developments.
- **Fake News:** Students will develop critical media literacy to question the reliability of information, identify bias and recognise intentionally false content.
- **Rules:** Students will understand that rules and laws are essential for protecting rights, ensuring fairness and promoting safety.
- **Consumers:** Students will learn about their role as purchasers, exploring the difference between needs and wants, and recognising the environmental impact of their financial choices.

Key Vocabulary	Definition
Consumers	Are people who buy goods and services
Reproduction	To create or recreate something, usually a new living thing such as a baby
Puberty	The name for the time when your body begins to develop and change as you move from child to adult
Fake news	Stories about current news that might make you feel worried or scared
Law	Set of rules that people are made to follow by the state
Trusted adult	Someone that you have a good relationship with and has your best interest in mind
