

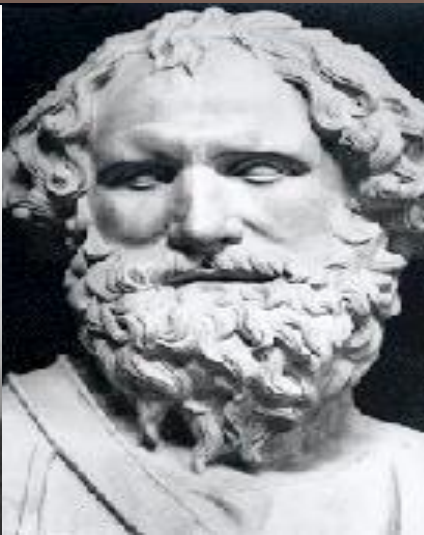

- Your chosen scientist can be from anywhere in the world but they must have made a significant discovery that has impacted the way we live today.



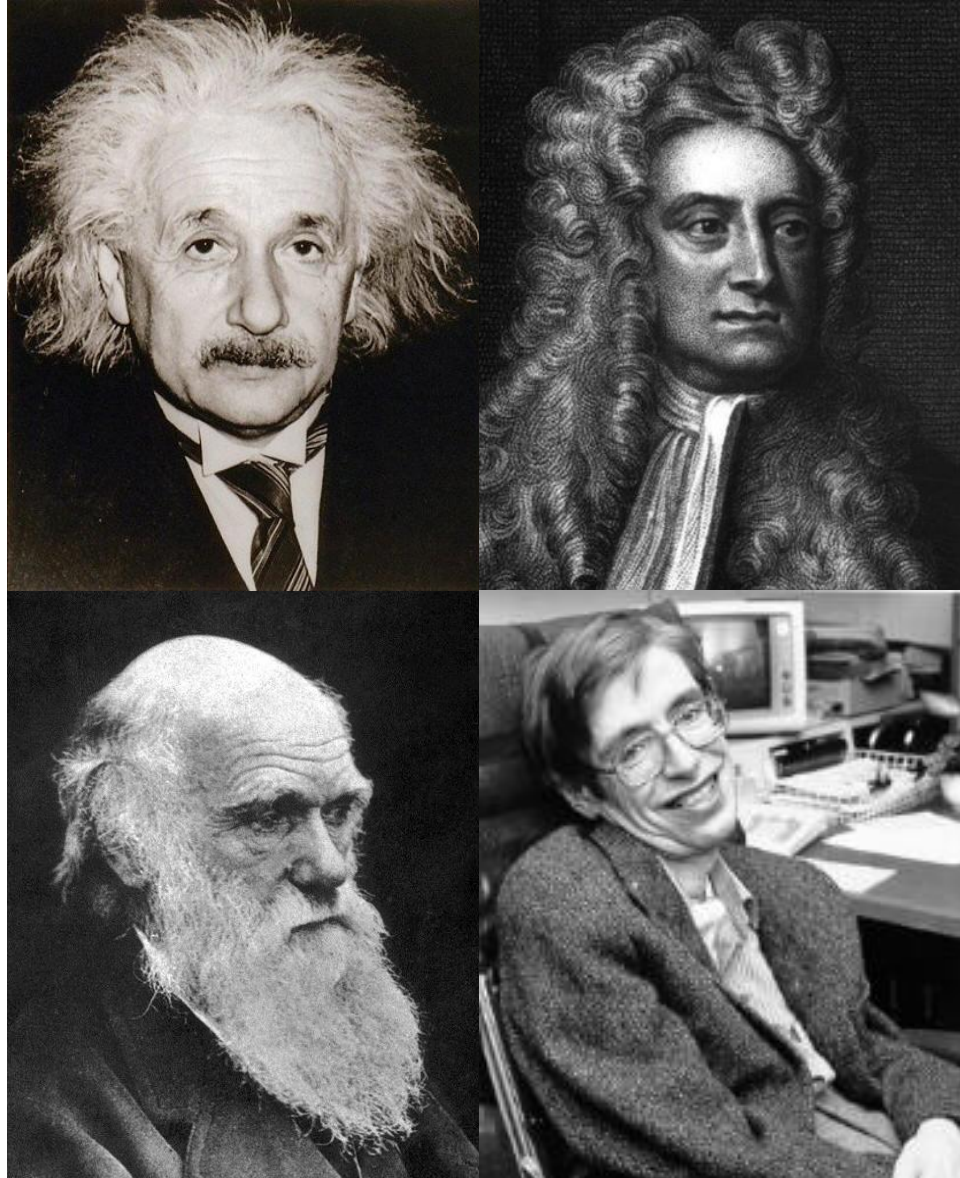
FAMOUS SCIENTISTS
