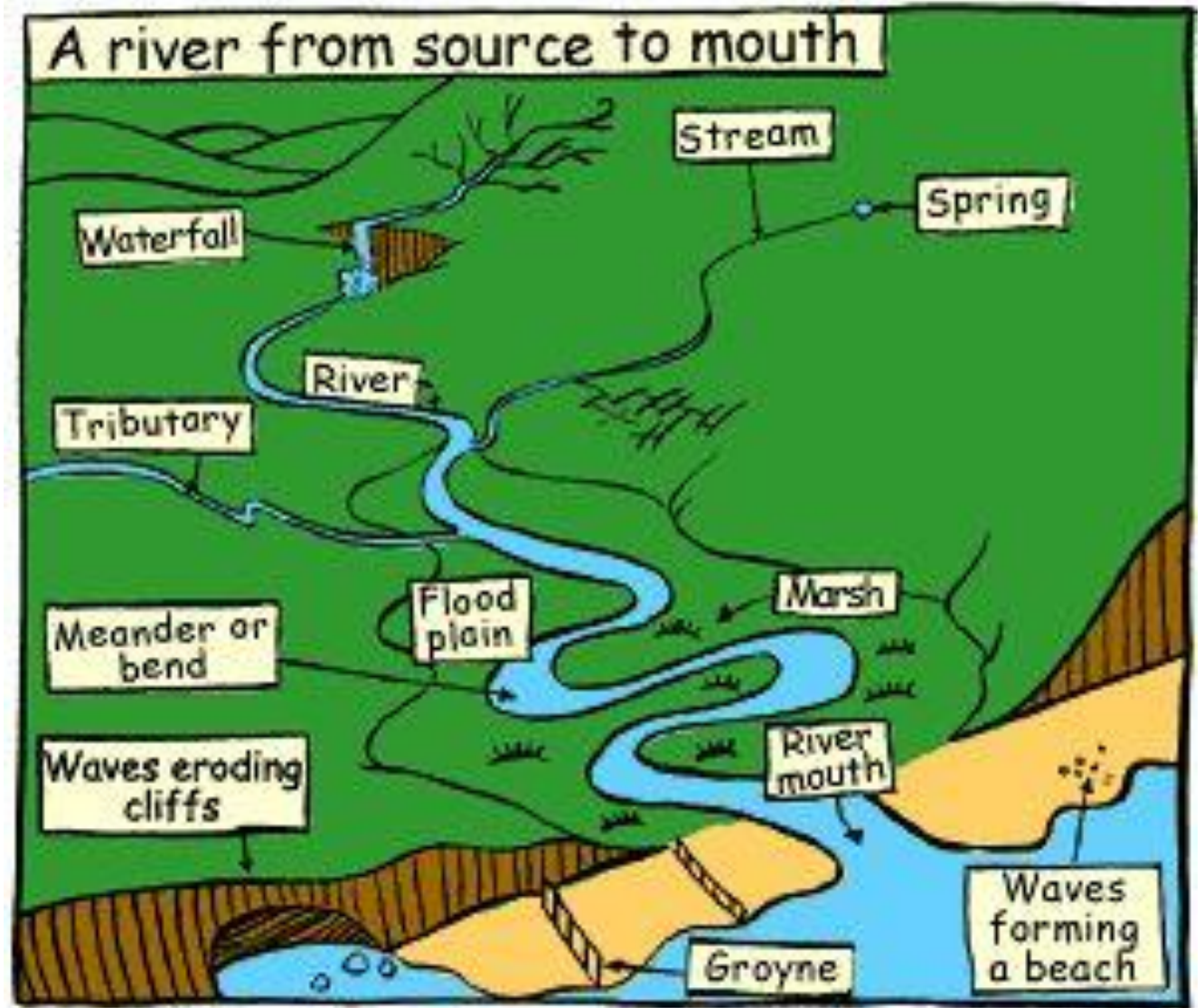
# RIVERS OF THE WORLD
