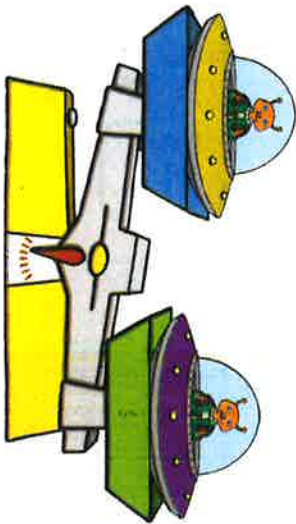

Which spaceship weighs **more**? Circle it.



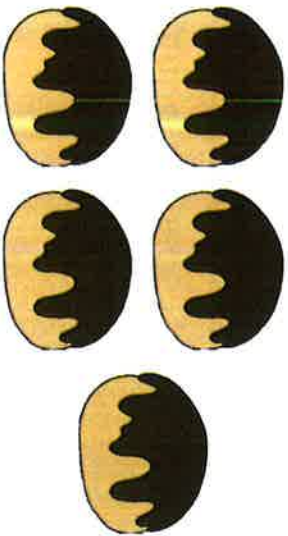

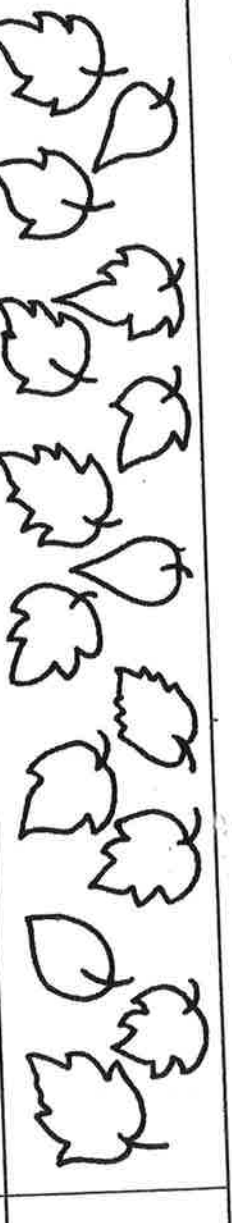
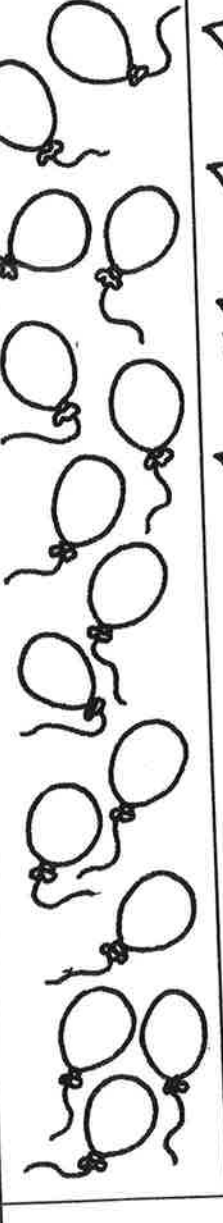
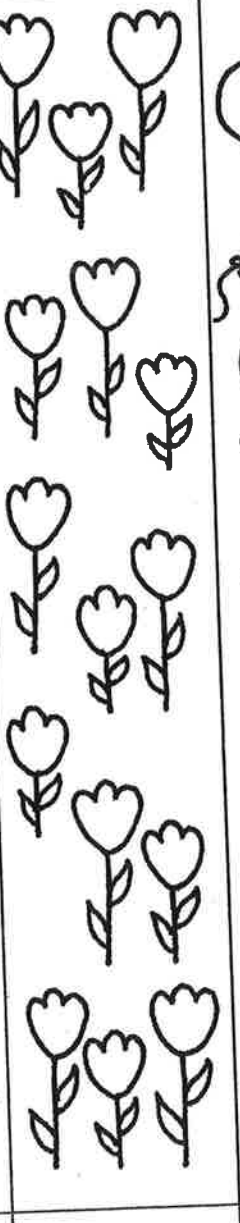
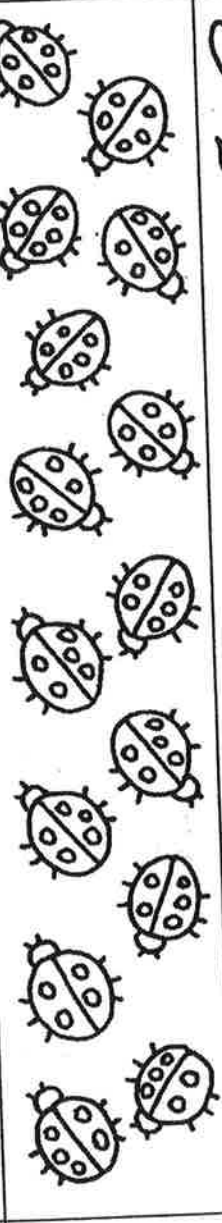
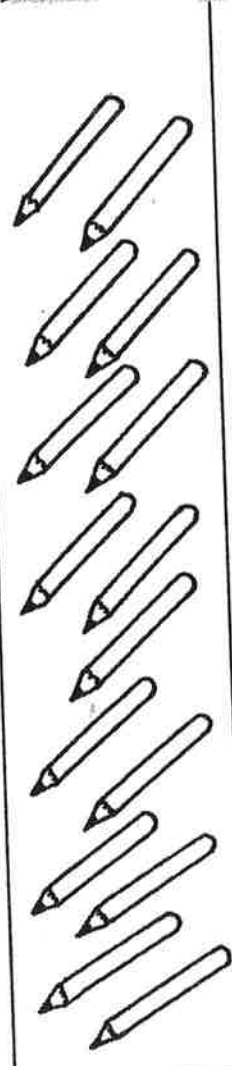


Numbers 10 to 15
