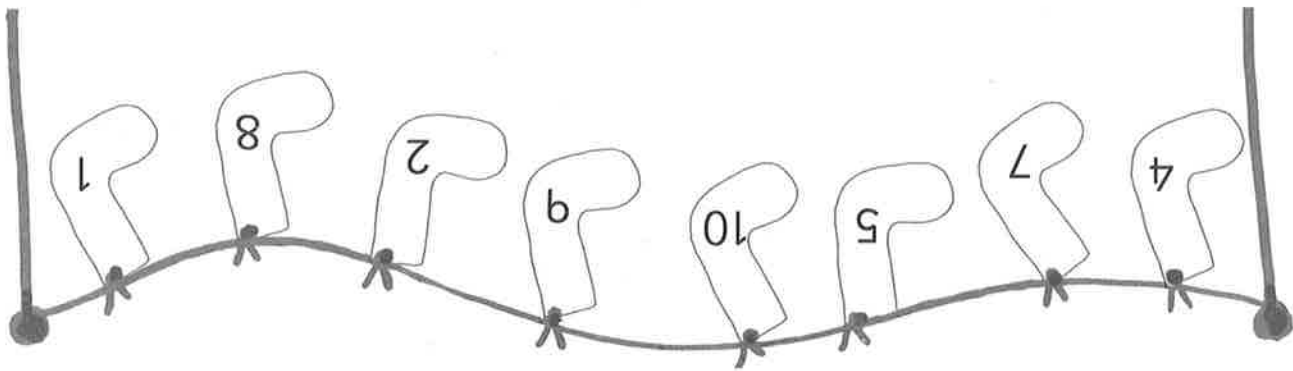
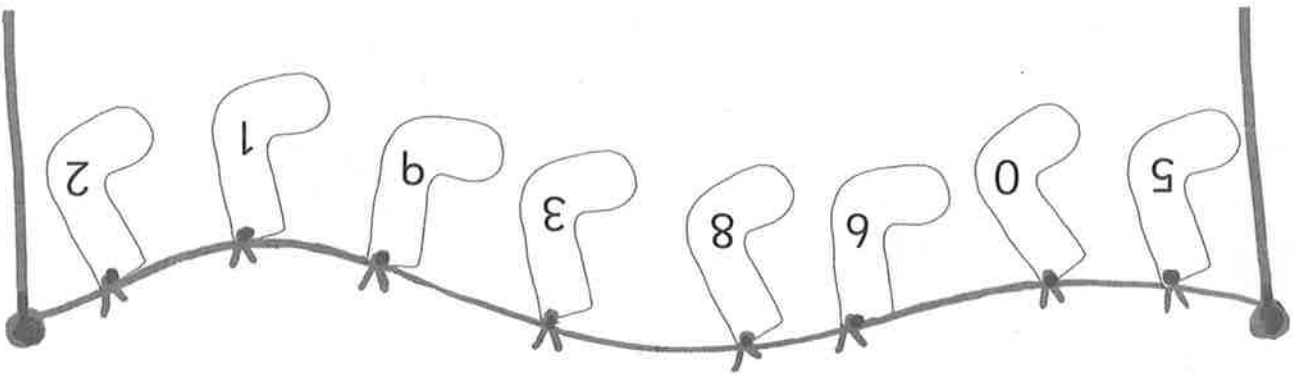

Addition facts for 10

Know pairs of numbers that add up to 10

- You will need:
- eight coloured pencils
 - counting objects, such as buttons and blocks



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What to do

- Ask your child to colour one sock on the top washing line and another on the bottom line the same colour to make a pair with numbers adding up to ten. Each pair should be a different colour.
- Then ask your child to write each addition fact for ten in the boxes below the washing lines.



From the addition facts for 10 that your child has written out, three will be missing: 4 + 6, 7 + 3 and 10 + 0. Work with your child to find out what the missing facts are, using counters and giving clues as necessary.
