EVOLUTION OF THE MINIFIGURE



1978: The first minifigures, seven in total, are developed for the town, space and castle themes.



1978: The first female minifigure – a hospital nurse – is launched.



1989: Minifigures change their facial expressions so they can either be good or bad. The pirate figure with leg and hook is introduced.



1990: The ghost becomes the first specialised minifigure.

• A **timeline** is a way of displaying a list of events in chronological order (from earliest to latest).
