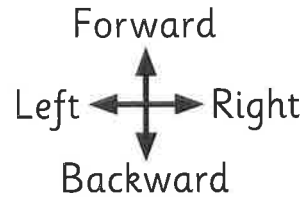

### Teacher's notes

There are four grid routes, but only three complete sets of directions – one set of directions is missing. Children move a toy person or building cube along each grid route to match it to the correct set of directions. They draw a line a line to match each route to the correct set of directions. They then write the missing set of directions and draw a line to the grid route.
