They are spelt the same but make a different sound.

Singular and Plural

Singular means that there is one of something, for example:

I have an apple.

Plural means that there is *more than* one of something, for example:

I have three apples.

Sametimes, to change a ward from singular to plural you add a 's' to the end of the noun.
