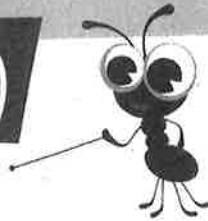

Then Ella gives him 5 more.

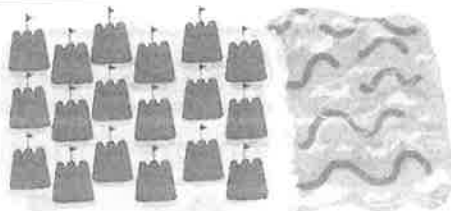
Now Samir has shells.
