Lesson Objective:
To plan a magical story

Planning

Use 'The Golden Net' as a basis for planning your own magical story. Plan your magical story in 3 clear paragraphs/sections: beginning, middle and end.

Title

Paragraph 1

▶ Beginning:

Introduce main characters and setting

Paragraph 2

▶ Middle:

Development in the story – action takes place (often with a problem that needs to be solved)

This should be the longest paragraph so will need the most detail.

Paragraph 3

▶ End:

Conclusion of the story

Planning Stage

- ▶ This is the planning stage so there is no need to write full sentences.
- ▶ It is a case of writing down ideas for each part of the magical story.
- ▶ Include key words that will trigger your final version later in the week.

Features of a Magical Story

- ▶ Beginning, middle and end
- ▶ Adjectives for description
- ▶ Conjunctions to help writing flow
- ▶ Clear paragraphs
- ▶ Capital letters and full stops
- ▶ Neatest handwriting

Structure

3 clear paragraphs

- ▶ Paragraph 1: **Beginning**
- ▶ Paragraph 2: **Middle**
- ▶ Paragraph 3: **End**
