Lesson Objective: To plan a magical story

Planning

Use 'The Golden Net' as a basis for planning your own magical story. Plan your magical story in 3 clear paragraphs/sections: beginning, middle and end.

<u>Title</u>

Paragraph 1

Beginning:

Introduce main characters and setting

Paragraph 2

Middle:

Development in the story – action takes place (often with a problem that needs to be solved)

This should be the longest paragraph so will need the most detail.

Paragraph 3

End:

Conclusion of the story

Planning Stage

- This is the planning stage so there is no need to write full sentences.
- It is a case of writing down ideas for each part of the magical story.
- Include key words that will trigger your final version later in the week.

Features of a Magical Story

- Beginning, middle and end
- Adjectives for description
- Conjunctions to help writing flow
- Clear paragraphs
- Capital letters and full stops
- Neatest handwriting

Structure

3 clear paragraphs

- Paragraph 1: Beginning
- Paragraph 2: Middle
- Paragraph 3: End
