Commands give you orders.

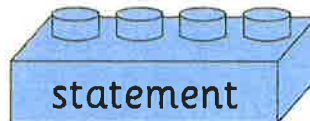
Put that down.

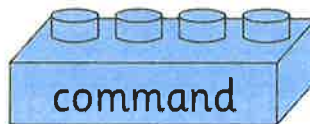
