describe nouns

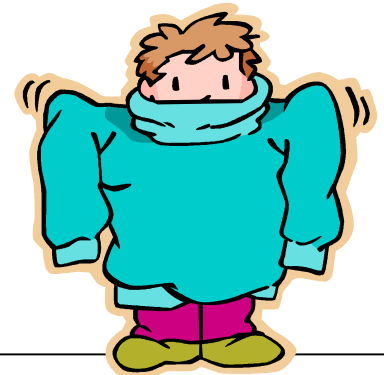
Adjectives are describing words

- The boy ran down the street.
- + ADJECTIVE
- The naughty boy ran down the street.



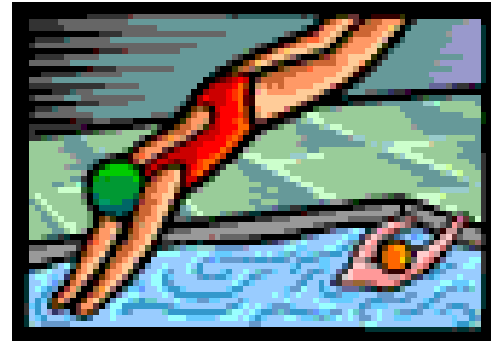
Adjectives are describing words

- I put on my jumper.
- + ADJECTIVE
- I put on my fluffy jumper.



Adjectives are describing words

- The dog went in the pool.
- + ADJECTIVE
- The dog went in the dirty pool.



Adjectives are describing words.

- I walked round the house.
- + ADJECTIVE
- I walked round the **creepy** house.

Adverbs are describing words

- The boy ran down the street.
- + ADVERB
- The boy ran quickly down the street.



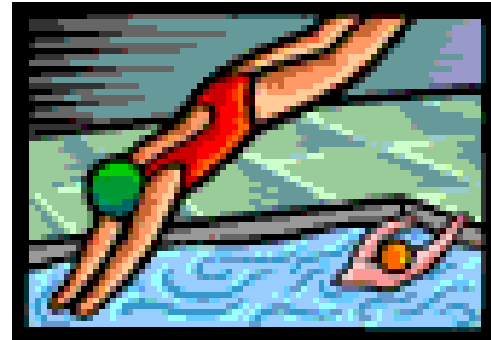
Adverbs are describing words

- I put on my jumper.
- + ADVERB
- I put on my jumper slowly.



Adverbs are describing words

- The dog went in the pool.
- + ADVERB
- The dog foolishly went in the pool.



Adverbs are describing words.

- I walked round the house.
- + ADVERB
- I walked silent^{ly} round the house.
