

## Staying in the Same Tense

**Verbs** in a sentence are usually in the **same tense**.

Both these verbs are in the **present tense**.

At break I **play** games and **paint** pictures.

Both these verbs are in the **past tense**.

Yesterday I **played** games and **painted** pictures.

Past tense verbs often end in **ed**.
