<u>Science - Parts of a Plant</u>

To identify different parts of a plant and explain their function.

- 1) If you have the opportunity, go out into your garden and try to identify as many flowering plants as you can. How many can you name?
- 2) Select a plant you have found, and try to identify the roots, its leaves, the stem and flowers.
- 3) Create an explanation text or a fact file. Draw pictures of your flowering plant and label each part. Explain the function of each part and try to draw your chosen plant.
