Activity 1 - Camera Angles

When television shows are recorded, more than one camera is often used so the subject can be viewed from different angles. Here are five **frames** showing different **camera angles** in a football match.



Watch one of your favourite television programmes. Observe and think about the different camera angles that are used. Describe or draw some of the different frames and consider why different camera angles have been used.

Activity 2 - Storyboard

Before filming a television show, the creators sometimes make a **storyboard**. A storyboard looks a bit like a cartoon strip and it is used to plan the order of the **scenes**, **camera angles** and **types of shots** to record.



Create a storyboard to plan your very own TV show on a topic of your choice.

Activity 3 - Filming

Practise using a camera (with your grown up's permission) and have a go at filming a short section of your show. You could even have a go at recording the same event from two different camera angles.
