3. Where were the puppies being held prisoner (*not just behind the brick wall*) ?
4. Find the quotation “‘They’re there!’ she said triumphantly.’ What does the adverb *triumphantly* mean?
5. a) Explain what ‘twilight barking’ involves.
b) Who finally received the message?
c) What three pieces of information did the message give them?
6. How did Pongo and Missis react to the message? Refer to the text to identify feelings.
7. What impression do you get of the Sheepdog in the text? Use quotations from the text to support your answer.
8. Try and summarise the main gist of the passage using newspaper-style headline e.g. “*Stolen puppies located! Parents alerted by twilight barking!*”
9. There are many differences between reading a story and watching the film version.
 - a) Create a table to list as many differences as you can think of between a story and the film version.
 - b) Which do you prefer and why?
