- 6. How did Pongo and Missis react to the message? Refer to the text to identify feelings.
- 7. What impression do you get of the Sheepdog in the text? Use quotations from the text to support your answer.
- 8. Try and summarise the main gist of the passage using newspaper-style headline e.g. *"Stolen puppies located! Parents alerted by twilight barking!"*
