1. Lachlan earned £37 on Monday and £98 on Tuesday. His Mum gave him £77 pocket money. How much does he have all together?
2. At the summer fair, Henry has a 'Guess how many Lego pieces are in a bucket' competition. I guessed 789 and my friend guessed 377. Henry said 'Put your guesses together, subtract 222 and you'll know the answer.' How many Lego pieces are in the bucket?
3. Each cake at the bakery stall cost 37p. Each biscuit at the bakery stall cost 98p. 117 cakes were sold. 90 biscuits were sold. How much money was made in total?
4. There were a 1000 bottles on the bottle stall. In the first hour 377 were sold. In the second hour 219 bottles were sold. How many bottles were left on the stall?
5. £1978 was raised from the summer fair. It cost £129 for food and drink. £399 to rent the field and £199 to rent the tent. How much money was raised?
