Art Task 2

Can you remember who Andy Warhol was and why he became famous?

In the 1960s Andy Warhol became known as one of the leading artists of the Pop Art movement. Andy Warhol was famous for exploring popular culture in his work. Popular culture is anything from Coca Cola to celebrities to the clothes people like to wear.

Pop Art is all about making art. You are inspired by things from popular culture.

Task:

To design and create your own Pop Art in the style of Andy Warhol. You will need to be working with **bright** paints/ coloured pencils/ felt tip pens or even crayons! Remember that Andy Warhol often repeated his designs changing only the colours he used. Be inspired!





Suggestion:

Find something that you really like. It could be a type of food, something sentimental, the outdoors, your smartphone, or even just you! Have a go at drawing one of these or a self-portrait. You can either use tracing paper to trace over your design (often 4, 6 or 9 as a repeated pattern is best) or you can even ask a grown up if you can use the printer to photocopy what you have drawn several times.

For each copy choose 2-4 bright colours and enjoy painting/colouring it in. Make sure that you change the colours slightly for each piece.

Once each picture is complete, cut it out and stick them on a sheet of paper side by side.
