- 1. On day one you will be researching endangered animals. Try to find at least three examples of animals that were endangered but made a come-back! These can be presented in a powerpoint, leaflet, poster – whatever you wish.**
- 2. Day two will be you designing an endangered animals' art-piece, think 3D! This should have depth to it, maybe the colour scheme is black and white to represent the pandas, or the display has ears/feet representing each animal.**
- 3. On day three, I'd like you to create your art piece. Be bright, be bold, make it imaginative! Imagine you're displaying this in an art gallery to help persuade people to help!**
- 4. Day four is finishing the art piece and adding snippets on information – wherever you think it should be. Written on the background, little signs all over, maybe hidden in the 3D elements!**
- 5. On day five I'd like you to bring it all together and create a script (or even film yourself doing it) of you presenting your work. Imagine you're presenting it to a room full of people willing to help the cause! Make links to charities like the WWF and make it very convincing!**
