What a difference a week makes! Since 1<sup>st</sup> June we have welcomed back around 90% of our children in Year R, 1 and 6 as well as the children of key workers and those who are 'vulnerable' in all other year groups. Following government guidance, the children are working in small 'bubbles' with a maximum of 15 pupils. They remain in these bubbles each day, with the same two members of staff; currently we have 13 groups at the Infants and 12 groups at the Juniors meaning all the teachers and teaching assistants are working with children, irrespective of the year group they normally work in.


We are so impressed with the children who have settled in to their new routine quickly and with smiles on their faces. Thank you all for preparing them so well and for your positive feedback:

Our staggered drop off and pick up times are working well at both sites. Please can I ask that only one parent accompanies each child and that, as adults, you adhere to social distancing requirements where there are many parents in close proximity.

### **Home Learning**

For those not at school, home learning continues as normal. Thank you again for your continuous support in helping your child learn from home while juggling work and other commitments. All our staff are working hard on teaching, setting lessons, delivering Loom and Zoom videos/assemblies, providing feedback on work submitted and contacting families and children individually.

Remote learning, available on the website, continues for all year groups (including Reception, Year 1 and Year 6) along with ZOOM assemblies for Year 2, 3, 4 and 5.

#### **Reports**

The teachers have written individual reports for each child based on their achievement to 23<sup>rd</sup> March. If your child is in Year R, 1 or 6 and is in school, you will receive a paper copy of their report. If your child is in Year 2, 3, 4 or 5 or is not in school, we will email your child's report. This is a new process and our intention is that everyone will receive their child's report by the end of the week. Emailing will take place over several days so please bear with us. There will not be Parent Consultation evenings this term.

## **Transitions for September**

Our hope is that, sometime in the not too distant future, we may be able to welcome all children back to school. At the moment, we are planning for 'business as usual' in September. Whatever happens, all the staff at South Farnham are dedicated to making the children's return to school as comfortable and welcoming as possible. Please rest assured that extensive planning is well underway regarding every child's transition to their new year group. Before the end of term you will receive a video from your child's new class teacher introducing themselves.

Even in these unprecedented times, we would like to provide an opportunity for children starting in Reception and Year 3 to meet their teacher, see their classroom and have a tour of their new school. We are planning this for the morning of Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> July; full details will follow.
