Year 6 Autumn Activities

The children in Year 6 have some exciting events taking place this term.

Visit to Natural History Museum

We will be visiting the Natural History Museum on the following dates:

Monday 30th October

6E and 6G

Monday 6th November

6P and 6S

We will be enjoying 'The Power Within' exhibition which focuses on Earthquakes and Volcanoes and their effect on the environment. This visit links with the geography curriculum for this term. We will be travelling by coach, leaving school promptly at 8.00am returning by 3.00pm. **Please ensure that your child is in school by 8.00am as we shall be unable to wait for latecomers.**

A packed lunch will be required. If your child normally has a school dinner a packed meal will be provided by the School Caterer. If you would prefer to provide a packed lunch from home, please tick the appropriate box online.

We would like some help on the day please. If you are able to help and have DBS clearance, would you please also indicate this online.

On **Friday 6th October** a representative from the Royal National Lifeboat Institution will be conducting short interactive workshop sessions with Year 6. The workshop will link with the children's PSHE&C curriculum and will cover the beach SAFE message, an introduction to the concept of beach lifeguards, the meaning of beach flags and safety signs, and what to do if somebody is in trouble in the water. It will encourage the children to develop skills to make safe decisions about water safety. This workshop is free of charge.

During this term the children will participate in first aid training. The Heart Start training is provided by the British Heart Foundation. This will cover calling for help, recovery position and resus. It will be appropriate for children. This is free of charge.

We would be grateful for a voluntary contribution of £17 towards the cost of these Year 6 activities. Please look for 'Year 6 Autumn Term Activities' in the payment items section of your Parentpay account. All necessary consents and information will be collected via Parentpay so there is no need to complete or return any additional paperwork.
