We're writing to let you know that we need to carry out essential work in your area. We'll be carrying out refurbishment work on Firgrove Hill bridge (Farnham). This will involve ultra high-pressure jet washing, painting with the use of water tankers as well as mechanical inspections of the bridge.

To carry out these works safely and working with the council, a full road closure with diversion route will be in place at the bridge for the duration of the works – see below maps as approved by the council. Pedestrian access will still be available on one side of the bridge throughout the works.

Please kindly note, once our team have cleaned the structure, if any bridge structural issues are identified, this work may be extended which would impact dates provided below.
